Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of BalVatika shall be restricted to 03 (one sections each in BalVatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 16 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sqft dimension.
2	During review, it has been observed that, the campus has multiple institutions within 25 acres of land and the whole campus is surrounded by concrete wall. The school area is separately enclosed with an iron fencing wall of 6 feet with separate gate for entry and exit, Thus, the school is directed to bounded the school with concrete boundary wall from all sides with minimum 6ft of height within 03 months and submit the videography link covering entire boundary wall from all sides in continuity in the compliance.
3	The land certificate submitted by school during review, is not in the prescribed format i.e. appendix – X. The land title / type of land ownership in which school's society has owns the land is not mentioned in the land certificate. Further, stamp of the issuing authority is in vernacular medium, its notarized translation has not been submitted. The land certificate submitted by school during review, is not in the prescribed format i.e. appendix – X. Thus, the school is required to submit revised land certificate in the above said format within complete details within 03 months in the compliance.
4	The school is required to apply for correction of land area from 6000 sqmtrs to 9712.45 sqmtrs as per land certificate and submit an undertaking in this regard within 03 months in the compliance.
5	The composite science lab has one workstation each for section of physics, chemistry and biology, which are very small and not sufficient for accommodating a class. The biology section does not have washbasin and chemistry section does

	not have gas connection. Hence, it is not set-up in light of Board's SoP for lab. The composite science lab has one workstation each for section of physics, chemistry and biology, which are very small and not sufficient for accommodating a class. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the same in light of Board's SoP for lab within 03 months and submit the compliance.
6	In the mathematics lab desks are placed adjacent to the wall, which is not appropriate. In the mathematics lab desks are placed adjacent to the wall, which is not appropriate. Hence, the school is directed to upgrade the Maths lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
7	The biology lab does not have washbasin in the workstations and chemistry lab does not have exhaust fan. The biology lab does not have washbasin in the workstations and chemistry lab does not have exhaust fan. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the said labs in light of Board's SoP for lab within 03 months and submit the compliance.
8	There is variation in the Society name, as per application and society registration certificate , name of the society is "Marougen Education Foundation", however in the recognition certificate it is mentioned as ""Marouen Educational Foundation. Thus, the school is required to submit the revised recognition certificate with corrected name of the society (as per society registration certificate) within 03 months and submit the compliance.
9	The seal and signature of the issuing authority in the building safety certificate are in vernacular medium. Thus, the school is required to submit the notarized translation of the same within 03 months in the compliance.
10	As per the application name of the school is "National Public School". However, in the fire safety certificate it is mentioned as "National Public School and PU College. The school should obtain Fire Safety Certificate in the name of the school and submit compliance within 03 months on SARAS portal.
11	The school is required to submit a Water test report to be issued by the PHED / Govt authorized laboratory within 03 months in the compliance.
12	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bengaluru within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from

filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
